Reestablishing Virtues of Self-Governance

America "was created in covenant with Creator God to be governed by His Laws, the Laws of Nature and of Natures's God."

Our founding fathers recognized the Ultimate Government that was ordained by the Ultimate Governor. (In other words; "Laws of Nature and Nature's God"²). They also recognized the Blessing of Covenant with the Ultimate Authority, and the maxim of law: He who creates, controls.

In reverence to their Creator, they established a government in accordance with the Ultimate Government; based on virtues and principles of the "Laws of Nature and Nature's God"³.

The Covenant was for freedom. God wanted His people to be free, but when they didn't honor their part of the covenant, bondage and slavery resulted. *Deuteronomy 28:12 and 13 (NASB)*; "The Lord will open for you His good storehouse, the heavens, to give rain to your land in its season and to bless all the work of your hand; and you will lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow. The Lord will make you the head and not the tail, and you only will be above and not be underneath, if you listen to the commandments of the Lord your God, which I charge you today, to observe them carefully." ⁴

Here in America, slavery existed even at the dawn of the early European settlements, because the settlers brought with them the practice of slavery. An exception to that, was the Pilgrims, who lived by virtuous principles. They brought no slaves with them and made a compact with the native people as a self-governing document. This document was called the Mayflower Compact (1620). This is when the pilgrims put God in the center of their government and agreed to "just and equal laws"5. Unfortunately, this belief and set of virtues did not pass on to all the rest of the New World. At the founding of our nation the subject of slavery was discussed, lamented, and argued about, but not disallowed. The result was that slavery continued in the areas of this nation where it was believed that one group of people can own and control another group of people. "It is recorded in history that the debate among the delegates of the Continental Congress in 1789, concluded with the Founding Fathers having agreed that the Slave Trade would end in 20 years after the adoption of the Constitution"6. The "decision to postpone the confrontation with the slavery issue, because it would die a natural death, had proven to be disastrous"7. The avoidance strategy failed. Even the American Civil War (1861-1865) did not resolve the issue. The 13th Amendment (1865) was intended to dissolve all slavery. However, it was

removed, and the 14th Amendment of 1868 made all the American people citizens (slaves).

The morality and virtues of the lawmakers and governmental officers were not strong enough to prevent or reverse slavery.

In order to address this breach of covenant, we need a backbone and an inner moral compass of virtues.

Without realizing it, every American will insure us for any loss we may incur and in this manner; every American will unknowingly be our servant, however begrudgingly. The people will become helpless and without any hope for their redemption and, we will employ the high office of the President of our dummy corporation to foment this plot against America."20

"We, therefore"²¹ (emphasis added), the People on the land known as Pennsylvania, America, "appealing to the Supreme Judge of the world for the rectitude of our intentions, do, in the Name, and by the authority of the good People"²² of this land, decree we have become the wiser and are no longer helpless and without hope! We "solemnly publish and declare"²³ that we take full responsibility to be vigilant, to self-govern, and govern affairs in our townships, county, and state by principles based on virtue to "secure the Blessings of Liberty to ourselves and our Posterity"²⁴.

Reestablishing Principles of Governance

Every Government, governing body, or organization, must define by what authority they govern.

- 1. The only reliable basis for sound government and just human relations is Natural Law.
- 2. Without virtue, the government of a free people cannot be maintained.
- 3. A free people cannot maintain a Republic unless they remain virtuous and morally strong.
- 4. One of the most promising methods of securing a virtuous people is to be virtuous, and to raise virtuous children by example.
- 5. Another most promising method of securing a virtuous people is to elect virtuous and morally stable leaders.
- 6. All things are created by God.
- 7. All mankind are created by God, therefore, upon Him all mankind are equally dependent, and to Him they are equally responsible.
- 8. All mankind are created equal.
- 9. The proper role of government is to secure and protect equal rights, not provide equal things.
- 10. All mankind are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights.
- 11. To protect the rights of mankind, God has revealed certain principles of Divine law.
- 12. The God-given right to govern is vested in the sovereign authority of the whole people.²⁹
- 13. It is the right and the duty of the people to alter or abolish a government which has become tyrannical.
- 14. The united States of America shall be a Republic.³⁰
- 15. A Constitution protects the people from the frailties of their rulers.
- 16. Life, liberty, and freedoms are secure only so long as the rights of property are secure.

- 17. The highest level of prosperity occurs when there is a free-market economy and a minimum of government regulations.³¹
- 18. There are 6 (six) branches of government: assemblies, militia, grand jury, legislative, judicial, and executive.
- 19. A system of checks and balances prevents the abuse of power by the different branches of government.
- 20. The unalienable rights of the people are most likely to be preserved if the principles of governance are set forth in a written Constitution.
- 21. There are only very limited and carefully defined powers that We the People delegate to the government; all others are retained by the People.
- 22. Efficiency and dispatch require that the government operate according to the will of the majority, but constitutional provisions must be made to protect the rights of the minority.³²
- 23. Strong local self-governance is the keystone to preserving the rights of the people.
- 24. A free people are governed by law and not by the whims of men.
- 25. A free people can only survive as a Republic with education which encourages evolution of our connection to and understanding of God consciousness.
- 26. Our mutually beneficial relations with all nations are based on peace, transparency, and creative collaboration.
- 27. The core unit which determines the strength of any nation, is the family; therefore the government fosters and protects the integrity of families.
- 28. The burden of debt is as destructive to the freedom of the people as subjugation by conquest.
- 29. The united States of America has a manifest destiny to be an example and a blessing to the entire race.

Affirmed and autographed by appellations in Grace, centered in Almighty God,

On March 5, 1681, Penn closed a letter to his friend, Robert Turner, with these words.

"...My God that has given it (Pennsylvania) me through many difficulties, will, I believe, bless and make it the seed of a nation. I shall have tender care to the government, that it be well laid at first."34

On August 25, 1681, William Penn wrote these words, regarding Pennsylvania.

"For my country, I eyed the Lord, in obtaining it; and more was I drawn inward to look to him, and owe it to his hand and power, than to any other way; I have so obtained it and desire to keep it; that I may not be unworthy of his love; but do that, which may answer his kind Providence, and serve his truth and people: that an example may be set up to the nations: there may be room there, though not here, for such an holy experiment."35
